

All Utah shooters are encouraged to attend and vote. You must have a current ATA average card or lifetime membership card present to vote. NO EXCEPTIONS. Voting will take place after the meeting.

TARGET REQUIREMENT PENALTY

- Shooters who do not have a combined total of 1,000 *singles* targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous target year will be advanced at least one class at the discretion of the classification committee. Shooters without an established average will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.
- Shooters who do not have a combined total of 1,000 *handicap* targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous target year will be assigned to the **23 YARD LINE** or their regular handicap yardage, whichever is greater.
- Shooters who do not have a combined total of 1,000 *doubles* targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous target year will be advanced at least one class at the discretion of the classification committee. Shooters without an established average will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher at the discretion of the classification committee.

*****ONCE AN EVENT HAS STARTED, THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS*****

SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All Special Category Shooters must declare their special category **at the time of classification** if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such a declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. If a classification error is discovered **BEFORE** the close of an event, the error shall be corrected for that event and all subsequent events. If an error is discovered **AFTER** an event is closed, all corrections shall be made for subsequent events only. In either case, all previous events the shooter shot in will be in the "Open Category". Either case may or may not affect the shooter's eligibility for the HOA and HAA, depending on when the error was corrected.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES

Lady I (54 and under), Lady II (55 and over)
Sub-Veteran (55-64), Veteran (65-69) Senior Veteran (70 and over)
Sub-Junior (under 15), Junior (15-17), Junior Gold (18-23)
All age-based categories are established on the shooter's birthday

ATA POLICY ON FALLBACK RULES WILL APPLY TO ALL EVENTS

The USTA will consider Special Category Championship trophies **superior** to Class Championship trophies. The intent of the USTA regarding winning of trophies is no shooter may win more than one trophy per event.

ANY SHOOTER WINNING \$2,000 OR MORE IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THEIR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER BEFORE ANY CHECKS WILL BE MAILED

CLASSIFICATION AND TROPHIES

HOA TROPHIES WILL BE BASED ON 1100 TARGETS (EVENTS #4-#13)
HAA TROPHIES WILL BE BASED ON 400 TARGETS (EVENTS #10, #12, #13)

1000 BIRD TEAM RACE: UTAH RESIDENTS ONLY

A 5-person team race will be held concurrently with the Championship Singles on Saturday. Any 5 Utah ATA shooters may form a team. Teams must be signed up prior to the beginning of **EVENT #12**. \$500 will be split 60/40 to the first and second place teams. There is no charge to enter.

2-IN-A-FAMILY RACE

A 2-in-a-family race will be held concurrently with the Championship Singles on Saturday. Any 2 family members may form a team. Teams must be signed up prior to the beginning of **EVENT #12**. Trophies will be awarded to in-state and out-of-state winners.

UTAH GUN CLUB WOBBLE CHALLENGE

Any 5 ATA members may form a team that will shoot one 25-bird round from the 24-yard line. One shot per bird, 25 targets per person. Cost is \$35 per team (\$7/round). Sign up begins Friday at the trophy window after the last event of the day; contest begins immediately after. Pays first and second place teams 60/40 of total entries. Targets are donated by the USTA.

SILVER SHOOTOUT OPTION FOR 5 oz OF SILVER

At the end of the day's events on Thursday (June 25), 20 qualifying participants' names will be randomly drawn for the shoot-off for 5 oz of silver. To qualify, you must play the silver shootout option in either Events 7, 8 or 9, or all three for a better chance at being drawn.

UTAH TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTION AWARDS

ATA GRAND American CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

A Champion of Champions event at the ATA Grand American is open to the most recent State or Provincial Singles Championship winner (or runner-up in the winner's absence) and the Special Category (Lady I, Lady II, Junior-Gold, Sub-Junior, Sub-Veteran, Veteran and Senior Veteran) winners (or runner-up in the winner's absence). All eligible Special Category contestants must be classified in the category they wish to compete in prior to squadding for the event. Participants must squad with the squadding manager at a time set forth in the ATA Grand American Program.

After participating in the Champion of Champions event, it is the responsibility of the qualified participant(s) to provide a paid receipt of said event to the USTA Secretary. After confirmation, the USTA will reimburse \$300 to the Utah State Shoot Singles Champion. All other participants will have their *entry fee* into the event reimbursed. However, receipts must be received **BEFORE September 1, 2026**.
